UAA UPDATE

We are preparing to begin our first evening student community in mid-October. Students will meet in a local home to prepare dinner and worship together. The student leadership team continues to meet every two weeks for sharing and encouragement as we work on our rule of life. Students currently meet on Fridays and Mondays for lunch and informal discussion. I got to eat lunch with six students one Friday and it was great to sit back and simply listen. They interacted, asked each other questions and made sure everyone got so share. They simply wanted the space in a big campus community of 14,000 students to find other peers who find faith in God a meaningful part of their life. I asked each of them to share what God means in their life. I heard story after story of how they've drawn closer and farther away from God at different points. They all came from such different backgrounds. One girl grew up outside the church in Russia but always felt close to God. She was recently baptized. Other students have been active in church but their families were not. Still other students went to a Christian school and are committed to continuing their faith journey during college. I was struck again with the reality of missional work. We aren't taking God to people. We're showing up where people are and realizing God's



been at it for a long time. We simply come alongside people and join their journey. We learn from them while strengthening and helping where we can. What a beautiful mix of give and take. "In giving, we receive."

One student shared: *I am very excited at this opportunity to be a part of a Christian community at UAA. The others that I have looked into don't seem to fit me and my beliefs quite right. I'm looking forward to a more open, loving, and questioning mindset.*

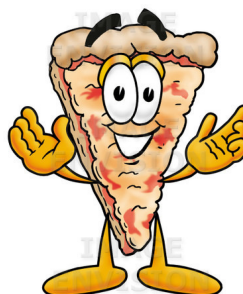

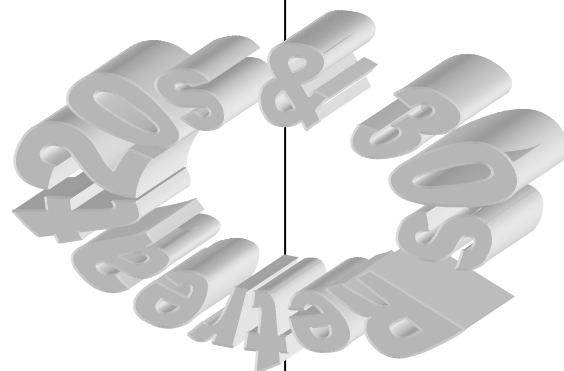
