### ZOOM FOR COMPUTER

Click the link to access the meeting directly. Firefox is not compatible with Zoom, please use Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, or Safari (mac users). Please note that you will have to download the ZOOM software to your computer, so I recommend that you click the link well before the meeting begins to give you plenty of time to do so. Once you have downloaded the software rather than clicking the link, you can open the software/app, click join meeting, and enter the meeting ID provided for a smart device.
