

Dave is well known to the Alaska United Methodist Church, serving over 20 years as a pastor in Soldotna, St. John UMC (Anchorage) and as Conference Superintendent, Dave's last appointment prior to retirement as a Sr Pastor of First UMC, Bend OR.

Participants will meet at 5pm to carpool from St. John UMC on Friday, March 7th. The retreat will end at 3pm on Saturday with closing worship.




