The families did not fall through the crack, but were able to be housed in hotels. And now it is time for us, as believers and followers of Christ, to answer the call to reengage with this amazing outreach ministry. We are being asked to help welcome families at the hotel where they are staying, providing them with care packages, help fill out the registration paperwork, and help them settle in. The plan at this time is to have an online sign-up so that AWAIC will know who to call on what days to help, with the idea being churches will again have a specific night on a rotating schedule of volunteers.
