We need everything at this point: cereals, oatmeal, pop tarts, granola bars, canned proteins like spam, Vienna sausages, tuna (or tuna in foil packets), beef jerky, chili, anchovies, soup, various crackers including graham crackers, peanut butter, macaroni and cheese cups, apple sauce, fruit cups, pilot bread and whatever else you can imagine. We also need boxed juice drinks. We also put hygiene products in the Blessing Box like tampax and kotex, tooth paste, body soap, hand sanitizer etc.

Please remember all cans need to be pop top cans. Most of the folks that frequent our box do not have can openers.

Let's stock up our pantry to the ceiling and keep this mission going strong. It is one small thing that we can do that actually makes a difference in the life of another person. Food insecurity is ugly. Blessings to all, Pam
